Make sure you have all the information for your workshop when you fill in the form: days available, materials needs, equipment needed, etc. Workshops, Demos and Tutorials can be 2hrs in duration, 4hrs (over 1 day), 8hrs (over 2 days) and 12hrs (over 3 Days). SUBMIT A PAPER Original Research papers on the topic of fab labs and society.

- PROPOSE AN ACTIVIVITY For the weekend Fab Festival we're looking for cultural activities, shows, dance, music, art -- anything that can help shape the festival's creative program. These activities will create interaction with the general public -- so be free to apply with whatever fun and interesting activities that you feel will inspire others!

CHEVRON STEM EDUCATION AWARDS 2017!

We are delighted to announce that Chevron is sponsoring the STEM Education Awards for the Fab Lab Network this year at FAB13.

Fab educators, both formal and informal, demonstrating innovative ideas teaching STEM using digital fabrication (including electronics and programming) and hands-on learning will be awarded cash prizes and an opportunity to share their work at Fab13 and across the network.

The Chevron STEM Education Award will include: a \$5000 1st prize, a \$3000 2nd prize and a \$1000 3rd prize.

Eligibility: An educator in a formal school or informal educational organization (such as museum, after school program, other NGO) that develops and/or delivers student courses or programming impacting STEM education for K-12 students (ages 5 to 18). **This includes approaches grounded in Fab Labs, that is, digital design, digital fabrication and/or programming and electronics.**

Application Process: Applications are due for consideration by midnight EST on **Friday**, **June 9th but will be reviewed on a rolling basis**, and should be submitted to bit.ly/cvx17STEMAwards.

Applications will be reviewed by a committee of network members. Labs submitting an application, are ineligible to review applications.

Winners will be informed by **June 23rd**, and formally announced during FAB13.

The Fab Lab network is an open source knowledge sharing community. Therefore, all submissions will be public and shareable throughout the network.



SCOPES-df Call for Content!

Are you interested in joining the Fab Foundation community to impact STEM learning through digital fabrication?

Fab Foundation's new *SCOPES -df* (Scaling a Community of Practice for Education in STEM through Digital Fabrication) project aims to catalyze STEM learning in formal educational environments through digital fabrication technologies and practices found in a Fab Lab or MakerSpace. During this initial phase, we are **collecting activities and projects from any educators engaged in STEM pursuits for K-12 learners**. The purpose of the call for activities and projects is to develop a compilation of digital fabrication lessons that have been aligned to standards and remixed a bit for open source distribution.

How can you help us seed this community building? We are calling any educators in the Fab Lab and Maker networks to contribute content by May 31st, 2017. To contribute, anyone can submit through the online form at https://goo.gl/dpMxgB or email ideas and files to SCOPESdf@fabfoundation.org.

Once collected the activities will be further developed and refined into digital fabrication lesson plans that are aligned to national U.S. standards, and later international standards. The final *SCOPES-df* lessons will be organized in a single format and attribute original content and sources to the contributor, and are open for release under a Creative Commons CC by SA license that permits their free use and re-purposing by others (this aligns with our <u>organization and network's charter</u>).

During the 2017-18 school year, we will work with a small cohort of schools to further develop curriculum and provide professional development, further building out the community of practice in person and through a new online community connected to our existing open communities of sharing on fablabs.io.
